REPORT OF SEMESTER I

The classes for 2017-2019 B.Ed batch of PKM College of Education began on 21 August 2017. Various activities were organized by the Department of Language Education, English during the first semester. Instructions were provided regarding the two-year course, the curriculum, and the different activities to be undertaken along with the course. Conceptual Awareness Test on Language and Subject Competency Tests were conducted in order to assess the awareness of student- teachers in language and the subject respectively. A Learning Community for the English Teachers, named **RESPLENDOR** was formed with the objectives of learning through sharing knowledge and learning in a joyful manner. GROUP ACTIVITIES

INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY

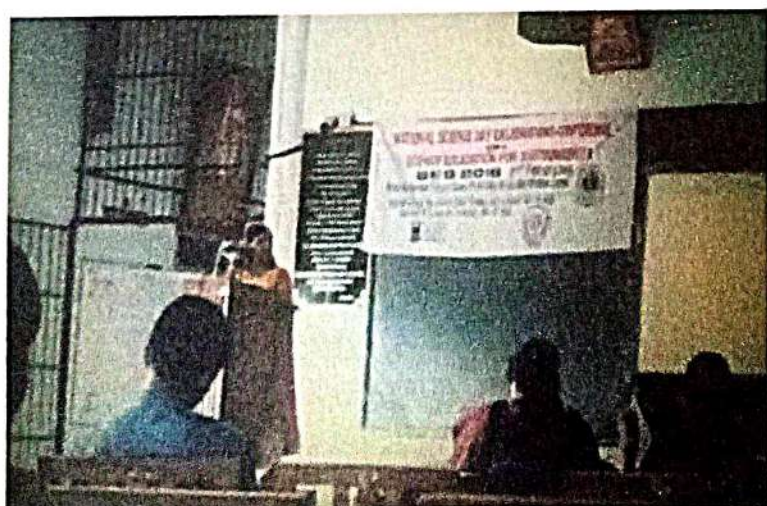

REPORT OF SEMESTER III

The Third Semester classes for 2017-2019 B. Ed batch of PKM College of Education began on 5 June 2018. The Department of Language Education, English organized demonstration and criticism classes for the student teachers before the commencement of their Internship period. Instructions were given regarding the Internship to be attended during the semester. A clear idea regarding the activities to be conducted during the period was given.

DISCUSSION LESSON PLANS

Instructions were given regarding how to prepare lesson plans. Discussions were held among the student teachers and lesson plans were prepared based on prose, poem, grammatical element, discourse etc. A lesson plan integrating grammatical element, discourse etc was also prepared. Corrections were made for the lesson plans written.

ACCLIMATIZATION

The student teachers of the Department had their acclimatization at two schools, GHSS Sreekandapuram and GHSS Nedungome from 18 June -21 June 2018. Ms. Littymol Thomas and Ranjumol.C.T attended their acclimatization at GHSS Nedungome, and Ms. Madhurima.E.P AND Ms. Manju.K.R attended their acclimatization at GHSS Sreekandapuram. The student teachers attended classes taken by their subject teachers at the schools, and they engaged in all the activities conducted at the schools. They met

their subject teachers and collected time tables and portions to be handled during their Internship period.

DEMONSTRATION CLASSES

The student teachers attended demonstration classes taken by teachers working in different schools. They attended classes taken by their subject teachers at the schools where they went for Acclimatization. On 22 June 2018, they attended a class taken by Mr. Libin, English teacher working at Sacred Heart Higher Secondary School, Payyavoor. Then they interacted with the teacher and had discussion on the classes. On 26 June 2018, they attended a class taken Ms. Riya Rose, the former student of English Optional subject of 2015-2017 batch. The class was arranged at Maryland High School, Madampam. Later they had a discussion with her from the English cum Method Lab.

CRITICISM CLASSES

The criticism classes were conducted in two phases at Maryland High School, Madampam. The student teachers selected a prose and poem each and prepared for classes to be conducted in two phases. The student teachers were allotted periods to be engaged in classes VIII and IX in the school. The first phase of criticism class was held on 26 June 2018. The teacher educator Dr. Rekha. K.R observed the classes, and in the afternoon session, evaluations were provided by the student teachers and the teacher educator at the English cum Method Lab. The second phase of criticism was held on 27 June 2018 at the same school. After that, evaluations were provided by the student teachers and the teacher educator in the afternoon session at the English cum Method Lab.

INTERNSHIP ORIENTATION

The student teachers were given instructions regarding the activities to be conducted at the schools allotted to them for Internship. The teacher educator gave instructions regarding how to written lesson plan. The student teachers were instructed to prepare

lesson plans on time and were also told to get them signed from supervising teachers every day before going to the class. Instructions were given regarding the digitalization of lesson plans which included video recording of about six classes including the Upper Primary, High School and Higher Secondary sections. Instructions were provided to write reflective journals and work diary every day.

ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY THE STUDENT TEACHERS DURING THEIR INTERNSHIP

The Internship period for Second Year B. Ed students of P.K.M. College of Education, Madampam began on 4 July 2018. The student teachers had training at both High School and Higher Secondary levels. ROLE PLAY

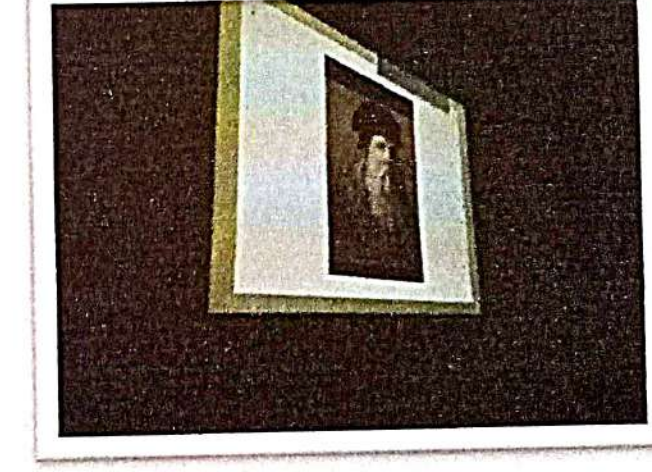

OBSERVATION OF CLASSES BY THE TEACHER EDUCATOR

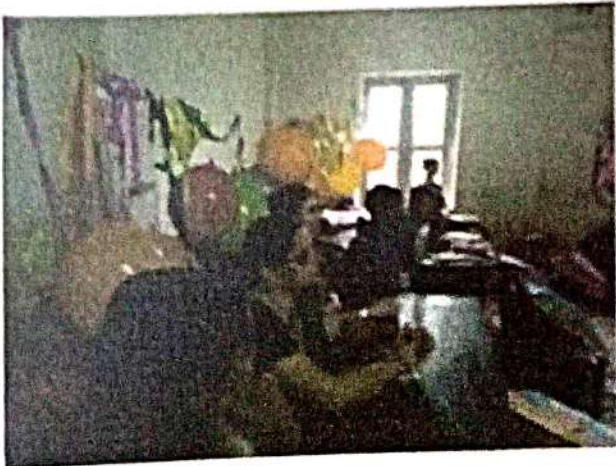
