The final electoral rolls were ready by 20th and final list of candidates for various posts was ready by 25th September. Election was to be held for three posts - Joint Secretary, Student Editor and University Union Councillor, with the rest of the posts filled without any opposition. On the day of election, the polling booth was arranged at the Social Science class cum method lab. Voting started at 9.45 am in the presence of Returning Officer, Presiding Officer Dr. Prashant Mathew, Polling officers - Dr. Sinoj Joseph, Ms. Jomol Jose and Mr. Rajesh K.J. and the polling agents and continued till 11.30 am. 96.96 percent poll was recorded.
